PAM PETROW ELECTED EXECUTIVE VP OF VECTOR SECURITY

At Vector Security Holdings, Inc. Board Meeting on December 7, Pam Petrow was elected to be Executive Vice President of Vector, according to John A. Murphy, Vector's President.
