



## ***Reassuring America Places 9<sup>th</sup> at Lowe's Motor Speedway.....***

The #72 Vector Security Busch Series car driven by Kevin Lepage placed 9<sup>th</sup> in the Dollar General 300 held at Lowe's Motor Speedway on Friday night, October 14<sup>th</sup>!

After qualifying 28<sup>th</sup> in a field of 43 cars including 17 Nextel cup drivers, Kevin Lepage drove our car consistently through the pack, taking the checkered flag in 9<sup>th</sup> place. This has been our best finish yet since we began sponsoring the #72 MacDonald Motorsports car in 2004. With this being our last 2005 start, our 9<sup>th</sup> place finish brought our season to a great close on a high note!

The Vector Security car beat the likes of Martin Truex Jr., (Bass Pro Shops) and Kasey Kahne (Great Clips) who finished 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> respectively and Kenny Wallace (Auto Zone) who finished 22<sup>nd</sup>.

With 75 laps left, the Reassuring America car was in 17<sup>th</sup> place but charged ahead and gained significant TV time.

In all, 19 cars left the race due to mechanical breakdowns or crashes including all three Lowe's cars who qualified 1<sup>st</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup>. Todd Bodine, driving the Dollar General Chevrolet, left the race but finished 39<sup>th</sup>.
